

International Money: Currency Conversion

Camilla Owl needs to change her money to the currency of the country that she is visiting. This is called **FOREIGN EXCHANGE**.

You can get this from most banks, post offices and currency shops. Look for a sign called 'Bureau de change'.



Here's the maths:

To work out how much foreign currency Camilla gets:
Bermuda currency x Exchange rate = Foreign currency

To work out how much money Camilla gets back:
Foreign currency ÷ Exchange rate = Bermuda dollars

Exchange Rates Table

Can you do the math to work out how much different currencies Camilla can buy?

Country	Symbol	Exchange rates for BMD
Australia	AU\$	1.83 AUD
European countries	€	1.11 EUR
USA	US\$	1.25 USD (BMD)
India	₹	95.03 INR

The Bermuda (BMD) dollar is the same currency as the USA dollar.
